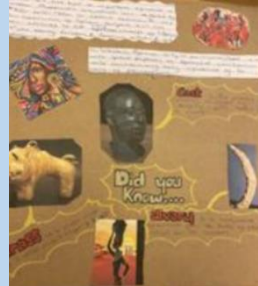
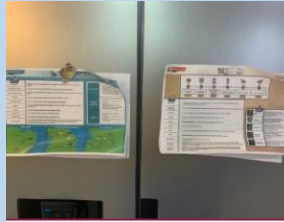


Hardwick Weekly Catch Up – 27th January 2023
