- Wear normal school uniform.
- Check your drop off and collection times. (If driving, please park away from the school, preferably use the community centre car park and do be vigilant for pedestrians)

COVID-19 rules in place at school from Monday 8th March:

- Adults must wear a face covering on site, unless exempt.
- Only one adult on site when dropping off and collecting EYFS and KS1 pupils.
- Maintain social distancing rules on site, outside the school gates and on the Greensward.

With everyone returning, I know there will be temptation to stop and chat and catch up with friends, but please remember we are still in lockdown and the rules about socialising, play dates, face coverings, social distancing, etc are still in place and must be strictly followed, so we can keep everyone in our school community safe and to keep the school open. We don't want any positive cases in school! We appreciate your understanding and support.
